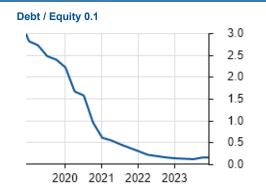

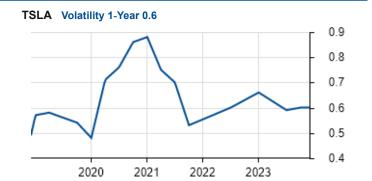

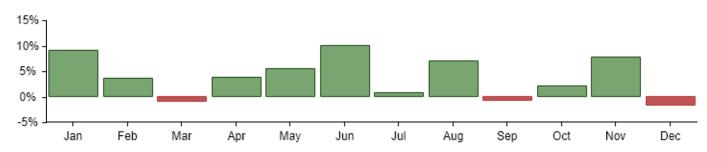

Overall Rating vs. Peers



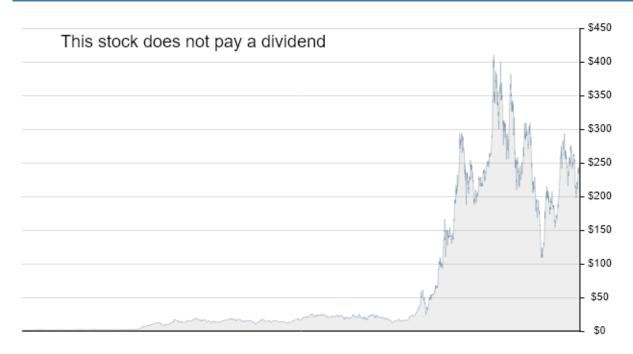

#### **Quantitative Scores**

#### Fair Value
